# Incredible Years Family Life Program

The Incredible Years program for parents is designed to increase a child's social and self-control skills. In addition, this program is used to reduce challenging behaviors in children.

This program targets parenting skills for children aged 3 - 12.

Meeting as a group, skills are taught through role-plays, homework, setting personal goals, and feedback. Taped video scenes are used to encourage group discussion, problem solving, and sharing of ideas. Parents are given handouts, activities to practice with their children, and reminder notes to put up at home.

The Incredible Years program for Children also uses role plays, homework, and video scenes.

### **Incredible Years Parent Groups**

The goal for parents who attend the parent group is to develop positive parenting interactions, coaching, attachment with children, and positive discipline.

This group looks to:

- Help parents strengthen their child's social skills, emotional control, and develop school readiness skills.
- Learn the use of effective praise and encouragement.
- Increase the use of positive discipline and develop effective ways to set limits.
- Learn positive communication and problem solving skills.
- Support and promote your child's education to help guide them to their fullest potential.

#### **Incredible Years Dinosaur Group**

The goal for the Dinosaur group is to focus on developing skills such as the expression of feelings, friendship skills, anger management, problem solving, school rules, and being successful in school.

Children who attend this group will:

- Learn anger management and selfcontrol skills.
- Detect, understand, accept, and verbalize feelings in themselves and others.
- · Learn problem-solving skills.
- Learn the behaviors necessary to be friendly such as helping, sharing, and teamwork.
- Learn positive school behaviors such as listening, waiting, and cooperating.
- Develop self-esteem and selfconfidence.
- Increase a child's school-readiness and academic skills.

The Incredible Years Dinosaur Groups are designed for children aged 4 - 8 years old. This group meets simultaneously as the Incredible Years Parent Group. In order for a child to attend the Dinosaur Group, a parent must be attending the Parent Group. It is important to note there is no childcare provided for children younger than age 4 or older than age 8. If you plan to register, please make child care arrangements prior to the start of the program.
