Objective: Franklin City School District (FCSD) is seeking proposals for the upcoming 2024-25 school year. The Board of Education approved a 1:1 Chromebook initiative beginning in the 2016-17 school year to increase the number of devices in the classrooms.

Scope and History of Project:

During the 2014 levy campaign, the Franklin Board of Education made a promise to increase the number of devices in the classrooms. This will be the seventh year of the 1:1 program that provides Chromebooks to students annually.

Goals:

- Increase access to technology for students in order to increase their engagement and productivity and to provide authentic, relevant learning experiences
- Allow learning to extend beyond the school day so students may learn anytime and anywhere
- Provide equal access to students with disabilities
- Increase students' 21st-century skills

Service Provider Criteria and Contract Requirements:

The devices designated for purchase are Chromebooks. The selection was based on durability, long battery life, and fast boot times. Chromebooks also support the district adoption of Google for Education for a technical platform. The Chromebooks are to meet the following criteria:

- 500 Lenovo 100e Chromebooks (G4 Mediatek or later)
- 500 Google Management Licenses
